STAIRWAY CONSTRUCTION

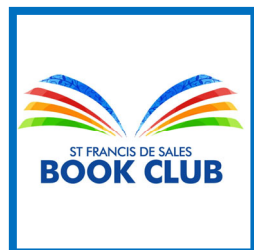

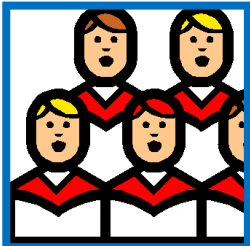
