## RCIA

### WE ARE ALL CALLED TO WELCOME NEW MEMBERS TO OUR COMMUNITY

You hear us mention “RCIA” or Initiation Ministry often enough here at St Francis but do you actually know what YOUR role in this process of initiation IS?

Currently we have quite a group of folks (9) asking questions about what it means to live a Catholic life, who we are as church and how they might go about joining us in our faith journey. Their curiosity is a blessing to us as a parish.

Our role is to recognize that the initiation of adults is the responsibility of all the baptized. (that’s us!) We are to give help to those who are searching for Christ. We are to be an example of faith in our words and deeds. We are to welcome candidates into our community gatherings, our homes and our conversations! We are, at the very least, to keep our candidates in our prayers as they prepare for the reception of their sacraments. (RCIA #9) OUR ROLE in this process is this: to be an EXAMPLE of FAITH! And so we ask you as the people of St Francis de Sales: how will you do this as we enter into a new church year? Come to a Monday night meeting and bring some cupcakes! Take a moment to talk with one of our candidates before or after Sunday Mass downstairs at Frank’s Café. Find out what it might mean to be a ‘parish sponsor’. (Ask Jayne) Think about what God might be asking of you, how can you share your gifts and talents with our newest members!

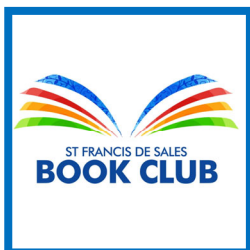
## BAPTISMS
