When we have reached capacity our ushers will not be able to seat any more folks, so please come early if you hope to attend Mass.

As we prepare for our Easter services we extend to you two ways more ways to participate: if you would like to contribute funds to help decorate the church for Easter, you may use an Easter Flower envelope which may be found in church, or make a special contribution on line for flower donations. Your help with this endeavor would be much appreciated.


