
A THOUGHTFUL REFLECTION ON THE CARDINAL'S CAMPAIGN

This weekend we are asked to do something called an “in pew” request for the Cardinal’s Campaign. We just wanted to share some thoughts with you regarding this within the context of the idea of stewardship -that spiritual practice we are all trying to grow in.

A while back Cardinal Dolan wrote a pastoral letter to his priests. In this letter he reminded his brother priests that when their people ask “Why do we need to give money to the Archdiocese? Why can’t we just support our local parish?” the pastoral response was that we are called to do both. As Catholics we strive to support both our local parish where we are nourished spiritually week after week, as well as the larger church, so that we can provide help, on a larger scale, both physical and spiritual for our brothers and sisters who need it.

Each of us, as members of a local parish, share the joy and the responsibility of being part of something larger than ourselves. When we contribute to the Cardinal’s Campaign we are truly helping to support the poor, the undocumented, the imprisoned, the hungry, all those works of mercy we as Catholics strive to practice. As we support this Campaign, we help other parishes who may be in less fortunate situations than we, to care for the needs of their parishioners.

It’s Lent. Isn’t this a perfect time to think beyond our own parish boundaries and prayerfully consider how we can help the Church in New York be a greater source for good in our city. Sometimes we may wonder “What can one person do?” to make a difference when we see such distress in the world around us. This Campaign is one part of the answer to the question. 


THE COVID VACCINE: A CHRISTIAN DUTY

Learn more about the exciting initiatives being planned including a speaker series, weekly Examen & Stations of the Cross during Lent, and a video project! The Catholic Anti-Racism Project (CARP) is comprised of members from three NYC Catholic parishes—St. Francis de Sales, St. Charles Borromeo/Resurrection/All Saints, and St. Francis Xavier—with funding provided by Catholic Charities of NY. This is a new initiative formed in 2020 to address the history of anti-racism within the Church and to document the experiences of African-American Catholics. We are collectively committed during these turbulent times to knit us together as the brothers and sisters we are so that we may share in the singular gift that is our faith.



THRIVE FOR LIFE PRISON RETREAT TEAM PROJECT

Br Zach Presutti, SJ and the Thrive for Life Prison Project have invited us, the parishioners of St Francis de Sales, to partner with them to create a new prison retreat team, from OUR parish. We are looking for 5 individuals who will commit to the training process involved in learning how to prepare and assist Thrive for Life in their Behind the Walls Retreat Program. (Once Covid allows for this work to begin again!)

The time commitment, after training, consists of giving one day a month (I think, usually Saturdays?) to go to the chosen prison and be a part of the retreat team for that day. Br Zach says that he is interested in forming a team here at SFDS that will work primarily with the women incarcerated at Bedford Hills and Taconic prisons. A few folks have already expressed an interest in beginning this new ministry project: are there any more interested folks sitting in our pews or watching us on live stream that would like to begin this VERY worthwhile work? 
