TYLER CLEMENTI FOUNDATION

The Tyler Clementi Foundation was created years ago after a young man, Tyler Clementi, took his own life when he couldn't live with the bullying and discrimination he had experienced as a young gay man. Recently they have undertaken a project that we as a parish have signed on to support. **"God Is on Your Side: A Statement from Catholic Bishops on Protecting LGBT Youth"** The statement says Jesus taught mercy and compassion for all, particularly those who are marginalized and persecuted, and that the catechism urges Catholics to treat LGBTQ people with "respect, compassion and sensitivity." This letter has been signed by 9 Catholic Bishops and many people of faith. We are proud to add our name to the list of signatures on this letter as a parish community that truly welcomes all in our midst. Esta carta ha sido firmada por mas de una docena de Obispos católicos y mucha gente de fe. Estamos orgullosos de agregar nuestro nombre a la lista de firmas en este carta como una comunidad parroquial que realmente da la bienvenida a todos en nuestro medio. 
