Today we hear in the Gospel how Jesus began his ministry; how he was sent to heal us, save us from our sins, and show us the path to eternal life. The readings also remind us that through our baptism, we become part of Christ's mystical body.

Every year, as Catholics of the Archdiocese of New York, we are asked to participate in the (Cardinal's) Annual Stewardship Appeal. This year's theme for the Appeal echoes the words of St. Peter: to whom shall we go? In times of uncertainty, Christ is our rock and His Mother is our refuge. With Mary's help, we can respond generously during this critical time for the Church and the world.

The funds that together we will give to this year's Appeal will be used to address the following needs of the archdiocese: Assistance for Financially Vulnerable Parishes, Charitable Outreach and Pastoral Support Evangelization (Youth Faith Formation), Communications, and Catholic Education, Formation of New Parish Priest and Care for Retired Priests.

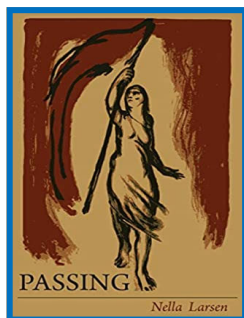

Catholic New York recently featured an op-ed [The Thrifting Catholic: Giving New Life to Old Things](#) which calls thrifting "countercultural" in keeping with Pope Francis' caution about a "throwaway culture."

Emily Hannon, the young mother who launched a secondhand store online, reminds us that a consumer culture pressures us to "buy, spend, accumulate more" so that we've lost the habit of "reusing or passing down things that may not be brand new but of value". NYC is full of second-hand stores, including [The Sharing Place](#), whose proceeds support the Little Sisters of the Assumption (LSA) health and social services in East Harlem. Check out their offerings. Consider recycling your no longer-needed and gently-used children's or adult's apparel to The Sharing Place or to outlets like [Housing Works](#) and [Goodwill](#).

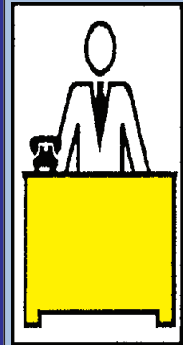
