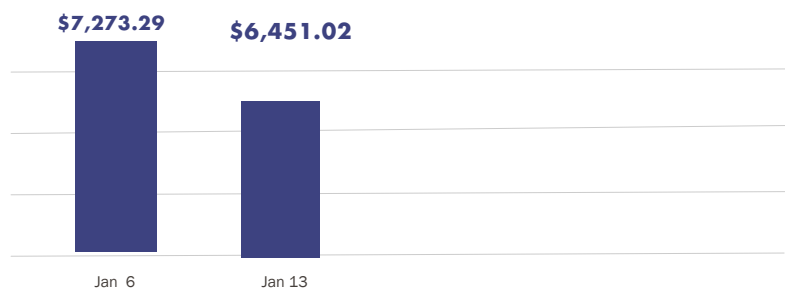
OUR FINANCIALS
