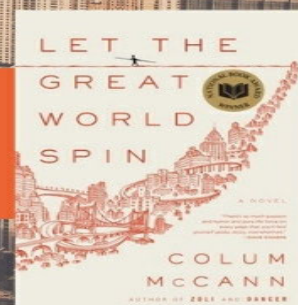
LET THE GREAT WORLD SPIN
