



## SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



**Baptism/Bautismo:** We celebrate the baptism of infants & young children on the third Sunday of the month during the 11:00AM mass. Baptism class is held the first Wednesday of the month. Bautizos en Español son celebrados el tercer Domingo del mes a las 12:30PM. **Come to the office to talk to a staff person to register for baptism Please bring Birth Certificate when you come in to register. Call us or visit our website for more information.**

**Marriage:** Couples should make an appointment at least 6 months in advance of possible date. Please call the Rectory and make an appointment with the priest.

**Sacrament of the Sick-** Please call and let us know if a family member is sick and would like to be anointed.

**Faith Formation for All—** Our Religious Education classes are held on Sunday Mornings (10:00 a.m.) for children in grades 1-8. In addition families are *expected* to participate in monthly Family Faith Days WITH their children, as well as Family Mass on the First Sat of each month (Oct-May) at 5p.m.

Children will participate in the program for a minimum of 2 years to prepare for sacraments.

Monday classes (4:00 p.m.) are offered for those older youngsters and their families who are seeking sacraments of initiation.

**Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.)**—Adults who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith gather on Monday evenings at 7:00 p.m. in the parish house. The door is always open to newcomers. All questions welcome

The media has been filled with news about the newest Papal Exhortation (letter) "Gaudete et Exsultate" (Rejoice and Be Glad). Pope Francis has written this new letter on the subject of holiness. I'm just beginning to read the letter myself and am finding it a wonderful reflection. Our own Patron St. Francis de Sales wrote a great deal on the same subject. Perhaps his most famous work, "Introduction to The Devout Life" is a treatise on how ordinary folks are able to find holiness in the midst of their own lives.

So often holiness is dismissed as something which is best left to the saints. Many of us are unaware that our baptismal call is a calling for each one of us to live out holiness in the day to day joys and struggles of life. In the letter Pope Francis writes of the importance of meekness a virtue dear to the heart of St. Francis de Sales. Rather than be understood as weakness, meekness is the capacity to create a heart where Jesus can find a home. It allies us with the poor of this world and allows for a solidarity between persons because it disallows a sense of superiority. It is one of the virtues which St. Francis de Sales rates highly as essential to the spiritual life.

"Gaudete et Exsultate" does of course speak to issues of which St. Francis de Sales would have had no knowledge such as the benefits and perils of social media. In creating a culture of compassion how can we use social media to foster better communication? What are the hazards of instant communication which does not vet information or calculate the cost of online gossip and detraction? In St. Francis de Sales time pen and paper allowed for a period of discernment between what was written and then communicated. In a digital age no thought or proposition is left unspoken very often to the detriment of a civil society.

## Baptisms


