



Baptism/Bautismo: We celebrate the baptism of infants & young children on the third Sunday of the month during the 11:00AM mass. Baptism class is held the first Wednesday of the month. Marriage: Couples should make an appointment at least 6 months in advance of possible date. Please call the Rectory and make an appointment with the priest.

Sacrament of the Sick- Please call and let us know if a family member is sick and would like to be anointed.

Faith Formation for All— Our Religious Education classes are held on Sunday Mornings (10:00 a.m.) for children in grades 1-8.

Children will participate in the program for a minimum of 2 years to prepare for sacraments.

Monday classes (4:00 p.m.) are offered for those older youngsters and their families who are seeking sacraments of initiation.

Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.)—Adults who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith gather on Monday evenings at 7:00 p.m. in the parish house. The door is always open to newcomers. All questions welcome

Staff Corner

This week I would like to talk to you a little about what it means to be a disciple. I think we often associate that word with some sort of unreachable star. We have so often been taught about the disciples of Jesus who were martyred and became the great Saints of the Church. We certainly view them in high regard and have come to some preconceived conclusion that being a "Disciple" is far from anything possible in my life. Well, if that is the definition we have of a disciple, of course we don't think we can live up to it, as a matter of fact I would dare to say that even the greatest of the disciples never found themselves worthy of that definition, but yet, they proudly called themselves disciples.

May I suggest that what God calls us to is not as profound as we think it is. A disciple is a person who seeks the opportunity to share God's love with others. I heard it said that the greatest evil in our world is that we have been convinced that holiness is unattainable. WE HEAR YOU!!

For the past few years we have used an electronic giving program called Parish Pay, which morphed into WeShare. We have heard that many of you have experienced technical problems with WeShare and we sought to do something about that. We have learned about a company called "**Tithe-ly**" and we want you to know that we are switching to this new company. These are the reasons for the switch: **Tithe-ly is:**

- 1. More user friendly on both the donor's end and the parish's end.**
- 2. Rates charged to parish for contributions is much less, 2.9% with Tithe-ly as compared to 4.1% with WeShare.**
- 3. Ability to access your financial giving history for tax purposed with greater ease.**



Renew and Rebuild Our Church of St. Francis de Sales

Do You know the founding date of our parish church? Do you know where to find the cornerstone for the answer? St. Francis de Sales Church was built in 1895 according to the cornerstone located on the westside of the building. (look by the doors to the parish hall)

Can you even begin to imagine how much repair and restoration work we could do here 123 years later? That is exactly the reason the Archdiocese has begun its Renew and Rebuild Campaign for each parish in the Archdiocese of New York.

Please pay careful attention to the information shown in the bulletin and to the pulpit announcements from Fr. Kelly today. Together, in prayer, we can do this!



Today we formally announce the Renew + Rebuild Campaign at St. Francis De Sales Parish. Renew + Rebuild is a \$200 million initiative for the parishes of the Archdiocese of New York.


