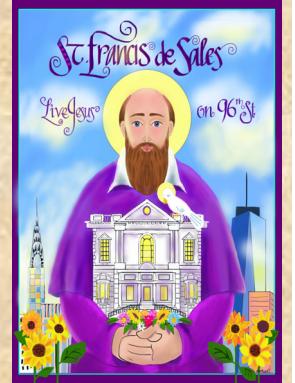

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION



Baptism/Bautismo: We celebrate the baptism of infants & young children on the third Sunday of the month during the 11:00AM mass. Baptism class is held the first Wednesday of the month. Bautizos en Español son celebrados el tercer Domingo del mes a las 12:30PM. **Come to the office to talk to a staff person to register for baptism Please bring Birth Certificate when you come in to register. Call us or visit our website for more information.**

Marriage: Couples should make an appointment at least 6 months in advance of possible date. Please call the Rectory and make an appointment with the priest.

Sacrament of the Sick- Please call and let us know if a family member is sick and would like to be anointed.

Faith Formation for All- Our Religious Education classes are held on Sunday Mornings (10:00 a.m.) for children in grades 1-8.

Children will participate in the program for a minimum of 2 years to prepare for sacraments.

Monday classes (4:00 p.m.) are offered for those older youngsters and their families who are seeking sacraments of initiation.

Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.)—Adults who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith gather on Monday evenings at 7:00 p.m. in the parish house. The door is always open to newcomers. All questions welcome

Tithe.ly/WeShare

We have learned about a company called “**TITHE-LY**” and we want you to know that we are switching to this new company. These are the reasons for the switch: **Tithe-ly is:**

1. **More user friendly on both the donor’s end and the parish’s end.**
2. **Rates charged to parish for contributions is much less, 2.9% with Tithe-ly as compared to 4.1% with WeShare.**
3. **Ability to access your financial giving history for tax purposes with greater ease.**

As we mentioned already here in the bulletin, we have certainly heard, (and experienced ourselves!!) that WeShare has been a less than optimal giving platform for our parish. Not surprisingly, it may not be as easy as we'd like for you to take yourself OFF WeShare, should you be ready to join us in our new Tithe-ly program.

Below, thanks to the kindness of Kathy Calderon, our office manager, are the 'simple' directions you will need to remove yourself from WeShare. We promise that once you are on Tithe-ly life gets so much easier, both for you, and for us!

If you, (like me...) have never VERIFIED your account on WeShare (when it transitioned from Parish Pay) you will FIRST need to verify your account with We Share in order to begin the process of cancellation.

The instructions to verify are:

- 1- you will need your parish pay user name
- 2- the last four digits of your bank account or credit card number that is currently being used for your donations
- 3- one of the following two options: the email you used to register with WeShare/Parish Pay or a collection name or specific amount donated in the last 6 months. (regular collection, special collection, etc...)
- 4- Once verification is complete, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to the We Share site.
- 5- At this point you can choose to cancel....(and move to Tithe-ly!)
- 6- If, (again, like me, Jayne) this is all too much for you, please feel free to call Kathy in the office and she will be able to help take care of this with and for you.

How Do I Do This On My Own?

A number of our parishioners who are **single parents** are looking to come together on Tuesday evening, **July 17th** to relax a bit and talk about their concerns as they try to navigate the challenges of raising children here in NYC. 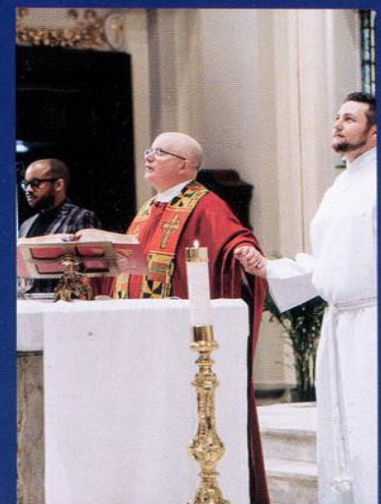
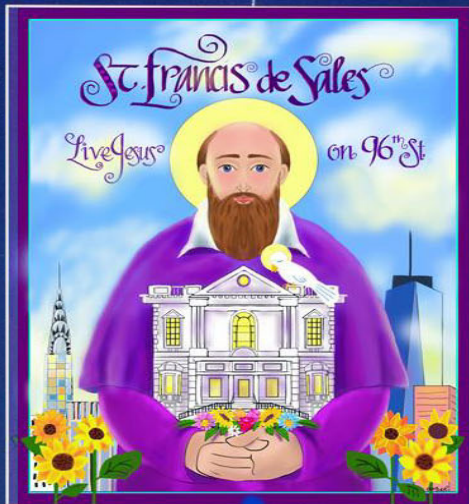

Renew and Rebuild Our Church of St. Francis de Sales

Do You know the founding date of our parish church? Do you know where to find the cornerstone for the answer? St. Francis de Sales Church was built in 1895 according to the cornerstone located on the westside of the building. (look by the doors to the parish hall)

Can you even begin to imagine how much repair and restoration work we could do here 123 years later? That is exactly the reason the Archdiocese has begun its Renew and Rebuild Campaign for each parish in the Archdiocese of New York.
