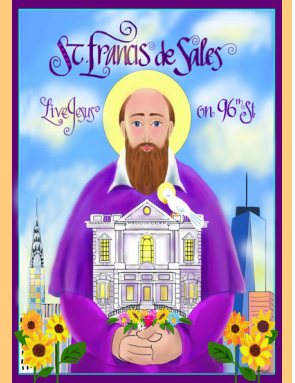

Baptism/Bautismo: We celebrate the baptism of infants & young children on the third Sunday of the month during the 11:00AM mass. Baptism class is held the first Wednesday of the month. Marriage: Couples should make an appointment at least 6 months in advance of possible date. Please call the Rectory and make an appointment with the priest.

Sacrament of the Sick- Please call and let us know if a family member is sick and would like to be anointed.

Faith Formation for All- Our Religious Education classes are held on Sunday Mornings (10:00 a.m.) for children in grades 1-8.

Children will participate in the program for a minimum of 2 years to prepare for sacraments.

Monday classes (4:00 p.m.) are offered for those older unbaptized youngsters and their families who are seeking sacraments of initiation.

Initiation for Adults (R.C.I.A.)—Adults who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith gather on Monday evenings at 7:00 p.m. in the parish house. The door is always open to newcomers. All questions welcome.

Tithe.ly

We have learned about a company called “TITHE-LY” and we want you to know that we are switching to this new company. These are the reasons for the switch: **Tithe-ly is:**

1. More user friendly on both the donor’s end and the parish’s end.
2. Rates charged to parish for contributions is much less, 2.9% with Tithe-ly as compared to 4.1% with WeShare.
3. Ability to access your financial giving history for tax purposes with greater ease.

As we mentioned already here in the bulletin, we have certainly heard, (and experienced ourselves!!) that WeShare has been a less than optimal giving platform for our parish. Not surprisingly, it may not be as easy as we’d like for you to take yourself OFF WeShare, should you be ready to join us in our new Tithe-ly program.

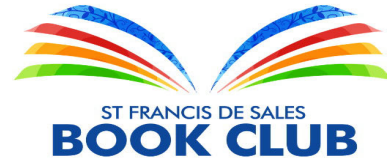
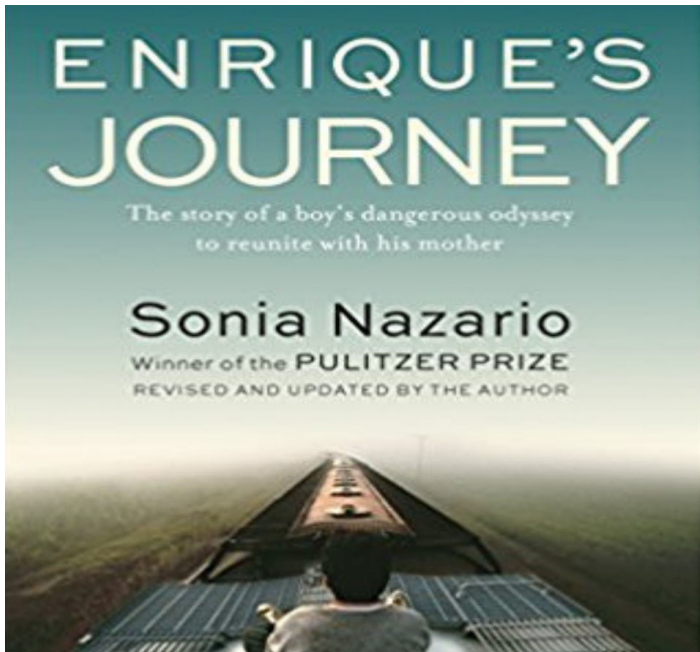

The Little Sisters of the Assumption Family Health Service in East Harlem is in great need for caring, responsible After School Volunteer Tutors

To assist low-academic performing East Harlem children (grades K-3 in our After School Enrichment Program). Participants are mostly immigrant children who struggle to perform at their grade level and can't always get the help they need from their parents. Tutoring is one-on-one. No previous tutoring or teaching experience required.

Tutoring will begin the first week in October 2018. Must be willing to make at least a semester long commitment, and ideally commit also to the spring semester 2019 which ends in mid June 2019.

Tutoring is on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:30-4:30pm. Ideally, the tutor can tutor twice a week, and it would be with the same child, both days.

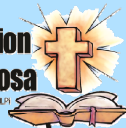

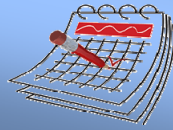

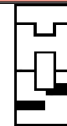
