OUR PARISH LAUDATO SI ACTION PLAN

Here's an ongoing opportunity for 'armchair' advocacy to slow global warming. Several SFDS members joined the **Adopt a District 12 (AAD NY-12)** team which periodically meets **via ZOOM** with our elected Representative **CAROLYN MALONEY** and/or one of her legislative staff to push her to sponsor key climate legislation. Over the past two years Rep. Maloney has sponsored 4 bills and held educational sessions on topics like converting the USPS electronic delivery vans and closing the carbon-spewing, asthma-aggravating power plant along the east river. Currently the interfaith ADD-12 team's 22 members include Catholics, Quakers, Unitarians and secular Jews from across Maloney's district. Some choose a speaking role, others just 'show up' to indicate strong constituent support for measures to reduce the carbon footprint. If interested email kristinkrausemcdonough@gmail.com

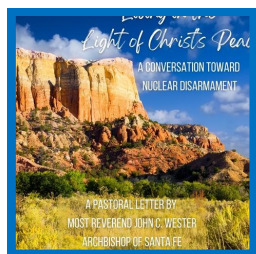

Aquí hay una oportunidad continua para la defensa de "sillón" para frenar el calentamiento global. Varios miembros de SFDS se unieron al equipo Adopt a District 12 (AAD NY-12) que se reúne periódicamente a través de ZOOM con nuestra representante electa CAROLYN MALONEY y/o uno de sus miembros del personal legislativo para presionarla para que patrocine una legislación climática clave. En los últimos dos años, el representante Maloney ha patrocinado 4 proyectos de ley y realizado sesiones educativas sobre temas como la conversión de las camionetas de entrega electrónicas del USPS y el cierre de la central eléctrica que arroja carbono y agrava el asma a lo largo del río este.

Actualmente, los 22 miembros del equipo interreligioso ADD-12 incluyen católicos, cuáqueros, unitarios y judíos seculares de todo el distrito de Maloney. Algunos eligen un papel de orador, otros simplemente "aparecen" para indicar un fuerte apoyo de los constituyentes a las medidas para reducir la huella de carbono. 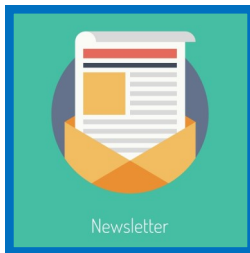

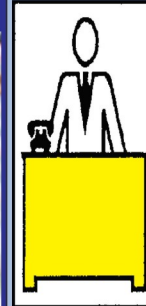
