FEBRUARY REFLECTIONS

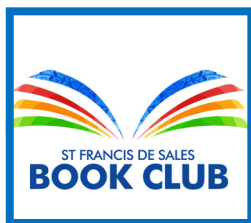
Take some time after Mass to talk about what the Gospel this week means for you, both adults and youngsters. Enjoy the insights your children can share with you!

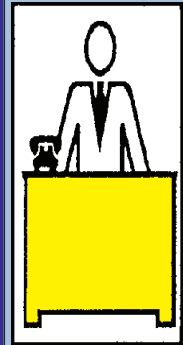
