ACTIONS TO CARE FOR THE EARTH

During this Season of Creation please pledge your support to the Care of our Common Home by. **Here are some suggestions:**

1. Say “Goodbye” to the top 4 single use plastics: plastic bags; water bottles; takeaway coffee cups; and plastic straws. Instead use cloth bags, reusable water bottles and cups, and fold-able bamboo, metal or glass straws. *Plastic takes 400 years to disintegrate. By 2050 there will be more plastic waste than fish, ton per ton. See The Great Pacific Garbage Patch (National Geographic).*

2. Replace my regular light bulbs with a compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) and/or light emitting diodes (LED's). A 100-watt incandescent (regular) bulb uses 75%-80% more energy than CFL or LED. *If every American household traded out just one incandescent light bulb for an LED bulb, the reduction in pollution due to fossil fuels would be equal to taking 670,000 cars off the road.*

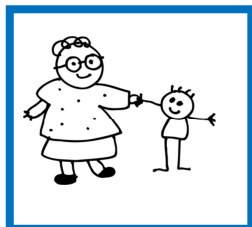

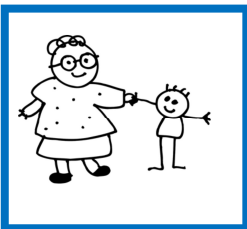

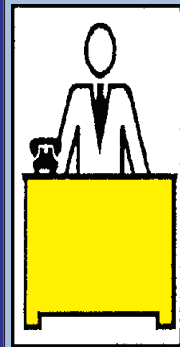
