### ACTIONS TO CARE FOR THE EARTH

During this Season of Creation please pledge your support to the Care of our Common Home by. **Here are some suggestions:**

7. **Use my car wisely. Drive Less:** Walk, bike, carpool or take mass transit more often. You'll save one pound of carbon dioxide for every mile you don't drive! **Keep your tires inflated:** improves gas mileage by more than 3% & keeps 20 pounds of carbon dioxide out of the atmosphere. **Wash you car in self-serve car wash.** Washing your car in the driveway causes polluted water to run into sewers. Self serve stations use around 12-18 gallons of water per vehicle, versus up to 100 gallons at home.

8. **Turn off electronic devices when not using them:** television, DVD player, Stereo, and computer. This alone saves thousands of pounds of carbon dioxide a year: About a quarter (25%) of all residential energy consumption is used on devices in sleep mode costing upward of \$19 million in electricity bills. Group appliances on power strips-you turn them off at the same time.

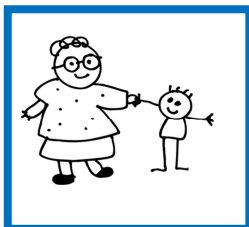

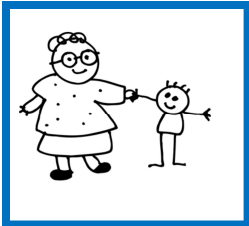

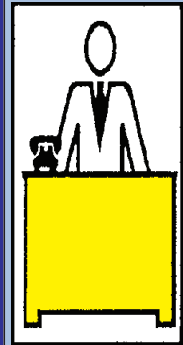
