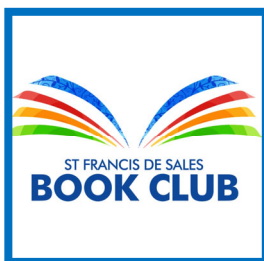
FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT
