ADULT FAITH FORMATION (RCIA)

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith for persons who are experiencing a conversion in their lives and seeking either Christian baptism in the Catholic Church or full Communion with the Catholic tradition of Eucharist and Confirmation. It is a process which enables the study of the Gospels, Catholic Christian teaching, the acceptance of Christian values and morality, the development and deepening of a life of prayer and action with the support and involvement of the local Christian community. Stewardship basically comprises how and what we do with the gifts that have been entrusted to us. How do I share my time, talents and treasure with this church community that I call home? We have a fantastic community here! In a real way you are already sharing in ministry by being welcoming and prayerful. In terms of treasure so many of you are signed up for electronic giving and this goes a long way in terms of stabilizing our finances, thank you! For those who haven't committed to consistent giving through an electronic platform, for us that is Tithely or We Share, I ask you to consider starting. Our numbers are good in terms of attendance. Our challenge is the culture of a City Parish. Unlike a suburban parish we don't see everyone always. We are a very young parish in terms of demographic, students in Med School and University, those just starting out and trying to get a hold on city life face challenges that sometimes get in the way of being here every Sunday. As a City Parish people are often from somewhere else, trips home, family responsibilities, social obligations can play havoc with regular attendance. We are grateful that you call this home and we want to be just that for you and everyone else who enters those front doors. In order to do this we need commitment from everyone who feel that this is a place where they are nurtured. To do this we need consistent giving in terms of not only paying the bills but growing, thriving. If electronic giving is not your preferred way, I ask that you commit to prayerfully deciding what it is you can give and make sure that it is consistent. So many folks in the City belong to a gym and of course understand that even if they are not using the gym every day the facility must be maintained, salaries paid, repairs made, new equipment purchased etc. As a community that depends upon a building to meet in, persons whose time and talent needs to be compensated justly, we see the connection. In a real way the value of stewardship is a matter of justice in terms of returning to God what belongs to God and trusting that God is never outdone in generosity. I thank you for your continued generosity. I invite those who may not give much thought to what and how they give to consider this in a thoughtful and prayerful way and I am confident that we will move in the right direction as a parish family.

La mayordomía en nuestra iglesia consiste básicamente cómo y qué hacemos con los dones que nos han sido confiados. ¿Cómo comparto mi tiempo, talentos y tesoro con esta comunidad eclesial a la que llamo hogar? ¡Tenemos una comunidad fantástica aquí! De una manera real, ya estás compartiendo el ministerio siendo acogedor y orando. En términos de tesoro, muchos de ustedes están inscritos para realizar donaciones electrónicas y esto contribuye en gran medida a estabilizar nuestras finanzas, ¡gracias! Para aquellos que no se han comprometido a dar consistentemente a través de una plataforma electrónica, para nosotros eso es Tithely o We Share, les pido que consideren comenzar. Nuestros números son buenos en términos de asistencia. Nuestro desafío es la cultura de una Parroquia de la Ciudad. A diferencia de una parroquia suburbana, no siempre vemos a todos. Somos una parroquia muy joven en términos demográficos, los estudiantes de la Facultad de Medicina y la Universidad, aquellos que recién comienzan y tratan de afianzarse en la vida de la ciudad enfrentan desafíos que a veces se interponen en su camino para estar aquí todos los domingos. Como la gente de una parroquia de la ciudad suele ser de otro lugar, los viajes a casa, las responsabilidades familiares y las obligaciones sociales pueden causar estragos en la asistencia regular. Estamos agradecidos de que usted llame a esto su hogar y queremos ser precisamente eso para usted y todos los que entran por esas puertas principales. Para lograrlo necesitamos el compromiso de todos los que sienten que este es un lugar donde se les nutre. Para hacer esto necesitamos donaciones consistentes en términos no sólo de pagar las cuentas sino también de crecer y prosperar. Si las donaciones electrónicas no son su forma preferida, les pido que se comprometan a decidir en oración qué es lo que pueden donar y asegurarse de que sea consistente.
