LAUDATO SI /SOCIAL JUSTICE MINISTRY

As a Laudato Si parish, our Social Justice Ministry (SJM) team honors Pope Francis with concrete Care for the Earth actions. Kristin McDonough joined Sisters Virginia Dorgan and Kathleen Kanet to support Catholic youth at a Press Conference on Sunday Sept 17 before the March to End Fossil Fuels. Students from 2 local Jesuit high schools, Regis and Loyola, shared how their faith fueled practical campus actions like recycling and reducing energy to help defend our planet as a common good. A young parishioner at Blessed Sacrament (where families created the tree and sun visuals for marchers) testified that 'Catholics are called to not only to love others but the world we inhabit'. Speakers then joined tens of thousands of marchers to demand that President Biden STOP all investment in fossil fuel pipeline projects and switch now to develop solar, hydro, wind alternatives.

Going forward the SJM team will share easy, practical lifestyle changes all parishioners can make to help preserve the Creator's planet for generations to come

ADULT FAITH FORMATION (RCIA)

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith for persons who are experiencing a conversion in their lives and seeking either Christian baptism in the Catholic Church or full Communion with the Catholic tradition of Eucharist and Confirmation. It is a process which enables the study of the Gospels, Catholic Christian teaching, the acceptance of Christian values and morality, the development and deepening of a life of prayer and action with the support and involvement of the local Christian community. 
