as we march as people of faith on **Sunday, September 17, in NYC.**



Why now? The global temperature broke records in July and August. We keep burning fossil fuels, which will only increase the warming and make matters worse. Alarmed, UN Sec. General Antonio Guterres has called for a UN Climate Ambition Summit on Sept. 20th to press global leaders to increase their ambition to reduce their emissions. We march to tell them to increase their ambition by ending the use of fossil fuels.

We call on President Biden to step up... to stop fossil fuel expansion and extraction by halting the Willow Project in the Artic, the leases in the Gulf, and the Mountain Valley Pipeline.

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process of initiation into the Catholic Community of Faith for persons who are experiencing a conversion in their lives and seeking either Christian baptism in the Catholic Church or full Communion with the Catholic tradition of Eucharist and Confirmation. It is a process which enables the study of the Gospels, Catholic Christian teaching, the acceptance of Christian values and morality, the development and deepening of a life of prayer and action with the support and involvement of the local Christian community.
