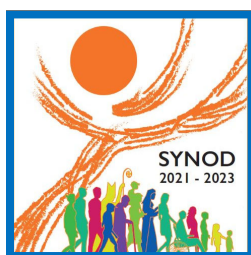
OUR NEW FRIEND: FR. STEVE KATSOUROUS, SJ

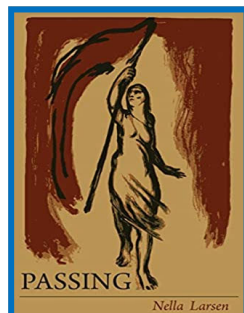
WEEKLY MASSES ADDED

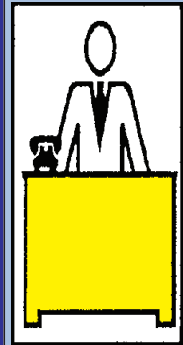
