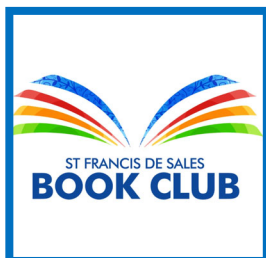
Getting rid of junk mail while helping to save the environment

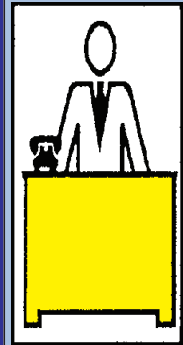
