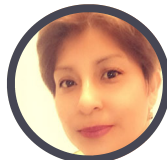

Franciscan St. Thea Bowman, born in the Jim Crow world of Mississippi, was a renowned teacher, speaker, singer and passionate promoter of civil rights and the reforms of Vatican II.

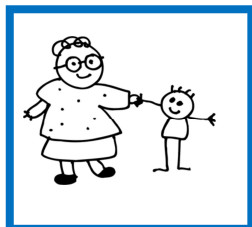

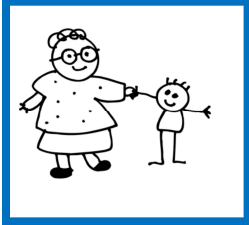

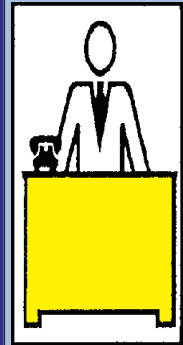
