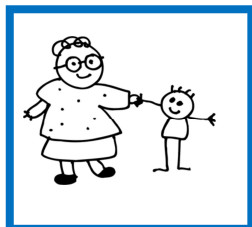

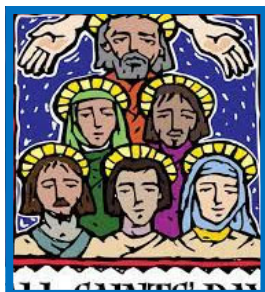


## A REMINDER FOR OUR FAMILIES

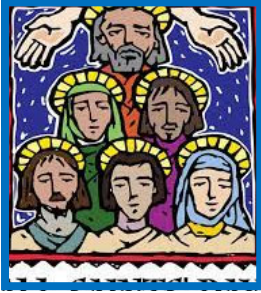


## DID YOU HEAR SOMETHING DIFFERENT?

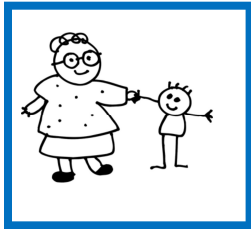


## SOLEMNIDAD DE TODOS LOS SANTOS Y DÍAS DE TODOS LOS FIELES DIFUNTOS

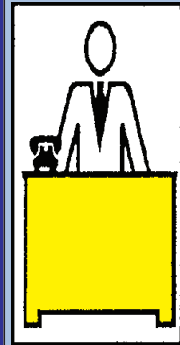
