LAUDATO SI /CARE FOR THE EARTH

There is nothing like two HUGE back-to-back family reunions at Jersey Shore shared beach houses to spotlight the range of opinions on actions we can take to reduce carbon emissions.

Here are small steps two clans of relatives — with differing points of view — are taking to reduce the use of plastics, paper, electricity, and cars over a summer fortnight when the living is easy.

The BEST part is that some of the solutions and compromises have come from the kids in the family.

ISSUE

Paper vs. cloth

Some families want paper napkins/plates and plastic cutlery for disposal after every meal. Others push for reusable plates, silverware and cloth napkins but are stymied when the paper brigade reminds us that this option *does* increase the use of both water and electricity.

Compromise

We try cloth napkins and 'real' plates and silverware for a week. A 10-year old grandson suggests that we use clothes pins to ID the napkin-owners for 3-4 meals and then wash and dry them on the clothes line in the abundant sun and ocean breezes. This saves 4 jumbo packages of paper napkins and hundreds of plastic forks. 12 yr old niece suggests that we use the 30 min efficiency cycle on the dishwasher but is vetoed when a college frosh organizes teams of cousins who wash and dry the plates, utensils and classes in 15 minutes after every feast, jiving to somebody's Spotify playlist.

Look next week for other creative solutions for reducing the use of plastic bottles, Ziploc storage bags, Amazon deliveries, and cars over this two weeks — all of which came from the next gen.

LAUDATO SI / CUIDAR NUESTRO PLANETA

No hay nada como dos ENORMES reuniones familiares consecutivas en casas de playa compartidas en la costa de Jersey para resaltar la variedad de opiniones sobre las acciones que podemos tomar para reducir las emisiones de carbono.

Aquí hay pequeños pasos que dos clanes de parientes, con diferentes puntos de vista, están tomando para reducir el uso de plásticos, papel, electricidad y automóviles durante una quincena de verano cuando la vida es fácil.

La MEJOR parte es que algunas de las soluciones y compromisos provienen de los niños de la familia.

TEMA

Papel vs tela

Algunas familias quieren servilletas/platos de papel y cubiertos de plástico para desechar después de cada comida. Otros presionan por platos, cubiertos y servilletas de tela reutilizables, pero se sienten frustrados cuando la brigada de papel nos recuerda que esta opción aumenta el uso de agua y electricidad.

COMPROMISO

Probamos servilletas de tela y platos y cubiertos "reales" durante una semana. Un nieto de 10 años sugiere que usemos pinzas para la ropa para identificar a los dueños de las servilletas durante 3 o 4 comidas y luego las lavemos y las sequemos en el tendedero bajo el abundante sol y la brisa del mar. Esto ahorra 4 paquetes jumbo de servilletas de papel y cientos de tenedores de plástico. Una sobrina de 12 años sugiere que usemos el ciclo de eficiencia de 30 minutos en el lavavajillas, pero es vetada cuando un estudiante universitario organiza equipos de primos que lavan y secan los platos, los utensilios y las clases en 15 minutos después de cada banquete, escuchando la lista de reproducción de Spotify de alguien.

Busque la próxima semana otras soluciones creativas para reducir el uso de botellas de plástico, bolsas de almacenamiento Ziploc, entregas de Amazon y automóviles durante estas dos semanas, todas las cuales provienen de la próxima generación.
