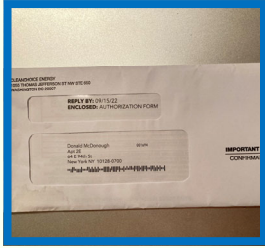

CARE FOR THE EARTH

You may be getting mail from **Cleanchoice Energy** – the same energy services company that sometimes takes a booth at greenmarket fairs (or Bestbuy). It is worth your opening the envelope and reading to learn that if you opt in, you continue to remain a Con Ed customer.

Con Ed will maintain the lines, bill you and provide reliable service including during climate-crisis related events such as power loss from storms. The big difference is that the electricity your home uses will be replenished by clean, renewable sources (solar wind, hydro) **NOT FOSSIL FUEL** which pollutes the air with carbon. The cost for renewable sources continues to decrease but it is likely that your bill WILL be a bit higher, especially during heat waves in homes that run air conditioners 24/7. Since there is no problem with switching back if the extra charges impact the household budget, SFDS parishioners might want to try this as an easy and convenient way to start reducing our carbon footprint. For folks who already recycle and compost, this might be a goof next step as we pledge during this Season of Creation.

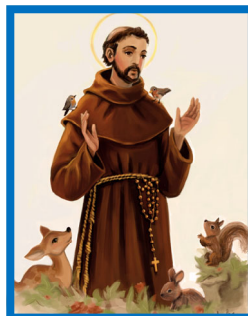
